

Frequently Asked Questions

Q What's the difference between Day 1 and Day 2 at Vision2020?

A Day 1, on April 7th, 2020, is a high-energy, high-impact event that costs \$20 to attend and includes keynote speeches, a community organization-led IMPACT zone, live music, reflective work time, and more. Day 1 takes place in Hall D at the Edmonton Expo Centre. Day 2, on April 8th, 2020, consists of small workshops in an intimate setting with the keynotes from Day 1. Day 2 costs \$70, this includes a ticket to Day 1.

Q When is Vision2020?

A The summit on April 7th, 2020 (Day 1) is from approximately 9:30am to 2:30pm, and the day 2 workshops on April 8th, 2020 are from 9:30am to 3:00pm - Buses should arrive around 9:00 am for dropoff and 2:40 pm for pickup.

Q How do I get in?

A You can buy tickets, and even pay online [here](#). Students in grades 8 through 12 are encouraged to approach their teachers to buy tickets for multiple students all at once, and book a bus for dropoff.

Q I want to attend on my own, not with my school, how does that work?

A You're welcome to come as an individual or with a parent or friend. Registration is online, we will mail your ticket to your home.

Q Can I pay at the door?

A Yes. In order to streamline the registration at the door, we're trying to register and receive payments ahead of time. Funneling 3000 people into an event can be challenging - but we'll take cash, mastercard, or visa at the door (may be subject to transaction fees).

Q Is lunch provided?

A No. Please bring a lunch.

Q Can I attend if I am not in Grade 8-12?

A If you are a University student, a professional, parent, or anyone else above the age of 13, you're welcome to attend. This Summit is for all ages 13 and up.
